The Lishman Health Foundation is an independent not-for-profit organisation, established in 1997 in honour of Dr Val Lishman, the first specialist surgeon to practise in south-west Western Australia. Dr Lishman was a lifelong proponent and supporter of the concept of regional health research to benefit regional populations.



Craig Challen

In July 2018 Craig participated in the Tham Luang cave rescue of 13 people in Thailand. He has been named as the 2019 Australian of the Year for Western Australia. Craig is an Australian cave explorer and member of the Wet Mules diving group. Notable explorations include the extension of Cocklebiddy Cave on the Nullarbor Plain of Australia in 2008 and the Pearse Resurgence in New Zealand over the last 10 years. Craig also has an avid interest in shipwreck diving and has explored sites over the last 15 years in the South China Sea, Solomon Islands, Australia, New Zealand, Thailand, Malaysia and Indonesia. A veterinary surgeon by profession, he founded the Vetwest (later Australian Animal Hospitals) group of veterinary practices in 1993 and ran it until selling his interest and retiring in 2017.



Dr Ahmed Kazmi

Dr Ahmed Kazmi is a real life GP who splits his time between London, England and Perth, Western Australia. He is an accomplished comedian and cabaret artist, having had successful sell-out seasons at prestigious festivals including Edinburgh Fringe and Melbourne International Comedy Festival. A firm believer that laughter is the best medicine, he draws inspiration for his performance work from the rich humour and tragedy he sees in his day job.
